1.0 Purpose of Report

The following report provides a community update and key performance information in relation to the Cleadon and East Boldon area over the past 8 weeks (report generated Saturday 4th July 2026).

2.0 Key Updates

Incidents

South Tyneside Area Command is showing a total of 40,297 incidents in the last 12 months (this is an increase of under 0.5% on the previous 12 months).

Within the Cleadon and East Boldon areas, a total of 248 incidents were reported to Northumbria Police in the current 8-week period.

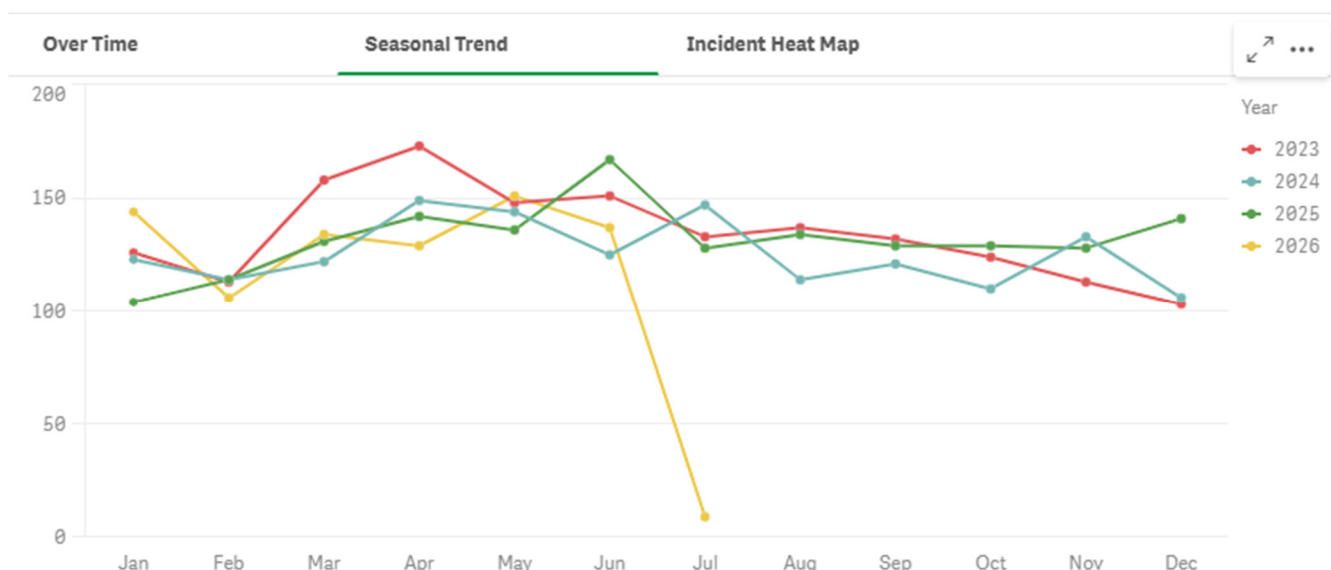
It is expected, in line with previous trends, that incidents will show a slight increase as we move into the summer months. This is typically a time when we see increased anti-social behaviour (both youth and adult) and an increase in the use of off road / electric motorcycles.

Throughout this report the following date periods will be used:

- This reporting period = 9th May- 3rd July 2026
- Same period 2025 = 9th May- 3rd July 2025
- Previous reporting period = 15th April- 9th June

Crimes

Of the 76 recorded crimes committed in the past 8 weeks, the highest categories of offences are as follows:

- Theft and handling – 24
- Violence against the person without injury – 17
- Violence against the person (with injury) – 7
- Public disorder – 7
- Criminal damage and Vehicle crime – 6

The street with the highest number of crimes for this period are:

- Station Terrace

Station Terrace

21 crimes at this location which are all shoplifting offences from Sainsburys.

South Tyneside has a dedicated shoplifting SPOC who is responsible for collecting and collating evidence of shoplifting offences allowing neighbourhood officers to tackle offenders as soon as possible. There have been several recent instances of offenders being charged with multiple offences across the Borough, which have resulted in prison sentences.

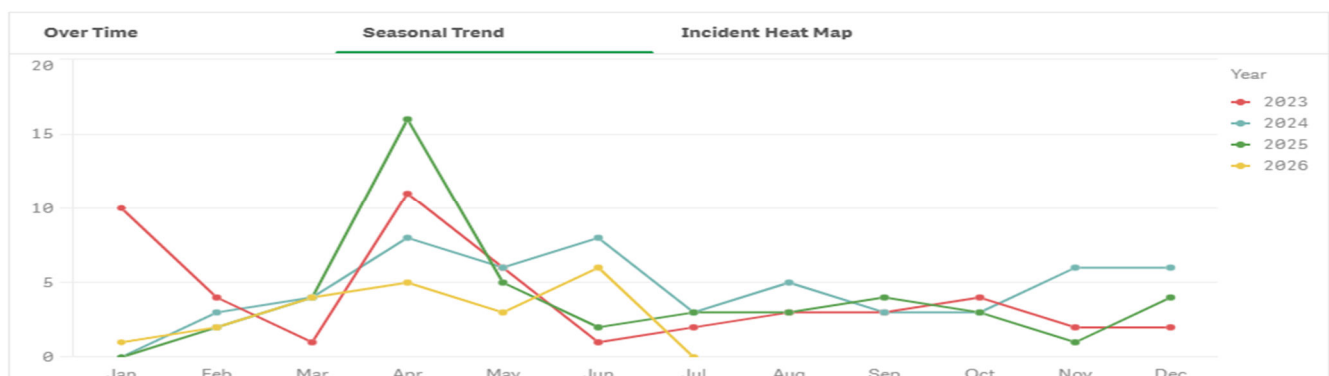

In the current 8-week period there have been a total of 9 ASB incidents, the highest categories are as follows:

- Motorcycle disorder – 20%
- Other ASB (nuisance) – 70%
- Other ASB (environmental) – 10%

NPT have conducted, and continue to conduct, dedicated patrols under Operation Coast watch and Project Guardian in ASB hotspot areas, as well as patrols throughout East Boldon and Cleadon. By working alongside colleagues from South Tyneside Council's Business and Community Responder Teams we continue to tackle those who cause ASB throughout the area and wider Borough.
